Dear Friend,

In 2016, The Afiya Center hosted the inaugural Texas Black Women's Reproductive Justice Policy Summit in Dallas. This was a convening of Black women leading the conversation on critical issues surrounding Black women, reproductive rights, and the abortion movement. As a result, we were able to lay the foundation for an intersectional policy agenda focused on groundbreaking solutions.

On February 15-17, 2018 in Dallas, Texas, the Texas Black Women's Reproductive Justice Policy Summit will convene again. We will explore how to integrate the reproductive justice framework and faith. There has been much rhetoric about how the faith community should engage in the work of reproductive justice. Despite the reality that most major faith beliefs have tenets that say one should show compassion, forgiveness, practice kindness and participate in acts of service to the poor and disenfranchised. So, what does it mean to be a person of faith engaged in reproductive justice work? Many question whether the faith community should even be involved.

This convening will bring together representatives of the faith community and various reproductive justice leaders to not only frame a space for RJ work and faith, but also engage in intentional dialogue regarding the intersectionality between the two and how to overcome ethical conflicts in order to be a part of a movement aimed at ending reproductive oppression.

To kick off the summit, we will host an opening reception: "The Faith Community + Reproductive Justice Movement" featuring The Afiya Center's Executive Director, Marsha Jones to guide the discussion.

Several elements of this summit offer unique opportunities for businesses and community leaders to invest in the ending of reproductive oppression for Black women in Texas, creating a more compassionate future for all women while also building goodwill in the community. The Afiya Center is dedicated to amplifying the voices of these women and ensuring they receive the full range of reproductive health-care choices in Texas and beyond.
